

## DIRECTIVES

*Host Federation* Berliner Turn- und Freizeitsport-Bund e.V.

*Competition Period* 18<sup>th</sup> March until 24<sup>th</sup> March 2022

*Registration Fees* 50€ per Team

*Team Entry* Until 04<sup>th</sup> March 2022

*Nominative Entry* Until 11<sup>th</sup> March 2022, 11:59 p.m. (MET)

*Teams*

- **Team Gold: YoB 2009 and earlier**
- **Team Silver: YoB 2009-2012**

Each team consists of 4 gymnasts. Each gymnast performs one routine.  
The apparatus are hoop, ball, clubs and ribbon.

*Judges* Each team must enter one judge.  
The fee for a missing judge is 50,00€.

*Rating period* Judges meeting: 17<sup>th</sup> March 2022, 8:30 p.m. (MET) via Microsoft Teams  
Start: with the first videos of the teams  
End: 27<sup>th</sup> March 2022, 11:59 p.m. (MET)

*Guidelines* The scoring will be carried out according to the Code of Points 2022-2024 (version valid in March 2022).

*Photos* Please upload individual photos of all team gymnasts with their entries. These will be required for the broadcast of the routines on the BTFB YouTube channel.

*Schedule*

Registration Period:

The registration deadline is on 11<sup>th</sup> March 2022 at 11:59 p.m. (MET).

Competition Period:

In this period all of the participants have the possibility to upload one video in their discipline.

After the video has been submitted for evaluation, it is checked whether it meets the requirements. As soon as the videos have been approved, the judges have time to give their assessment. Assessment will be completed by Sunday, 27<sup>th</sup> March 2022.

Match-Code:

With the start of the competition on 18<sup>th</sup> March, the match codes can be requested. A separate match code must be requested for each routine. After generating the match code, the code is valid for 6 hours. During this period, the exercises have to be recorded and uploaded to the platform.

*Awards*

Participation certificates for all gymnasts (via e-mail). The winning teams (place 1-3) of each category will receive trophies.

*Results*

The results will be published on **02<sup>nd</sup> April 2022**. A video with the routines of the gymnasts will be streamed in the time of **12:00 noon until 1:30 p.m.** (silver category) and **2:00 until 3:30 p.m. (MET)** (gold category) on to the BTFB's YouTube channel: [www.youtube.com/SuperBTBTV](http://www.youtube.com/SuperBTBTV)

- The judges register themselves for the e-tournament. In order to register as a judge for an e-tournament, an "e-Referee" account with Sportdata is required.

## JUDGES REGISTRATION

To register as a judge (referee) for a competition, the following steps are necessary:

- Log in with the e-Referee account
- Check referee data
- Provide information about the judging license
- Select this e-tournament in the event calendar, then click on the "Registration" button for the event
- Register as an e-Referee for this event

### Videos

Only one video can be uploaded per gymnast. To ensure that the recordings are current, a so-called "match code" must be shown at the beginning of the video. The video may not be edited (editing, filters, fades, texts, etc. can lead to the video being rejected). ## INFORMATION ON DATA PROTECTION

It is in the nature of an e-tournament that data is collected, stored and processed for participation and evaluation.

The uploaded videos will be visible to everyone. The result lists with details of name and registered age group will be published digitally.

By registering for the e-tournament, the person registering assures that the participant and their legal representatives agree that all data provided may be used in the context of this e-tournament, including the necessary contact.

Furthermore, the consent is given that within the scope of this e-tournament image, sound and video recordings on which the participant can be seen can be used for public relations in the BTFB's online media. Insofar as there are indications of ethnic origin, religion or health from the photo and / or video (e.g. skin color, headgear, glasses), the consent also refers to this information. Using the data and recordings for purposes other than those described above or placing them on the market by transferring the recordings to third parties outside the framework described above is not permitted. Consent is given voluntarily. All parties involved are aware that this declaration of consent to the use of image, sound and video data can be revoked at any time. In the event of revocation, the recordings will be removed from the respective platform. If the recordings were available on the Internet, they will be removed as long as they are subject to the control of the initiator.
